Welcome to the new 311 HIVE newsletter. As you have noticed it is in color, it has a grip of merchandise, it's free, and it needs your input.



The band appeared as part of the Warped tour which included Pennywise, The Vandals, Mighty Mighty Bosstones, Reel Big Fish & Royal Crown Revue, as well as bmx bikers, skateboarders, and in-line skaters. 311 traveled via RV's and camped in tents along the beautiful coastline "down under." It was a great tour with the exception of one major tragedy. As many of you already know, during a recreational game of football in Sydney, Australia Chad Sexton fractured his wrist. His arm was set in a cast and he was forced to fly back to Los Angeles to meet with his doctor. Although Chad's musical contribution to 311 is irreplaceable - the band (with Chad's blessing) enlisted the help of Josh Freese (drummer for The Vandals) in order to keep the tour going. 311 persevered with Josh behind the kit and even though Chad was sorely missed - the shows went great.
