311 is a funky rap-rock-reggae band originally from Omaha Nebraska. The five members of the band are:

The band began playing together as **311** in 1990. Their first REAL show was opening for Fugazi at Sokol Hall in South Omaha on June 10, 1990.

From that time on, the band was busy playing to packed houses in many Omaha venues, as well as performing in other cities throughout the midwest.

311 produced several albums itself in Omaha, all of which sold well. The crowds of faithful fans grew larger and larger, culminating in a farewell concert at Peony Park in Omaha in February '92.

311 moved to Van Nuys Ca in March '92, renting a home (with a pool) and started to work almost immediately. **311** attracted the attention of Eddy Offord. (Eddy is a well-known record producer, having worked with YES.) He saw the talent and strength in **311** and they made a demo tape in LA.
